ORDINANCE NO. 10-151-2000

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE COMMERCIAL UTILIZATION AND/ OR SALE OF THE QUARRY MATERIAL EXTRACTED IN EVERY QUARRY AREA PURCHASED OR MAY BE ACQUIRED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF IPIL.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

From the start, the present Administration, under Mayor Rey Andre C. Olegario and the agguniang Bayan, envisioned a proactive and self-reliant local government. Thus, at the proper time, an ditional set of heavy equipments (grader, dumptrucks, vibratory compactor, and a payloader) augmented the wy equipment purchased by the previous Administration. To further flesh out the envisioned plans, a 2-hectare arry area at Palomoc was purchased, to provide item 200 gravel material, so basic for the fundamental layering of id projects.

With this latter acquisition, it has therefore become imperative that a tariff ordinance is formulated govern and regulate the exploitation of this rich natural resource. It is the intention of the local government to wide for the basic gravel needs (item 200) of the road development projects for the 28 barangays, to include the placion area. However, since the quarry site has revealed such a rich source, its commercial merits have been

speculated on, necessitating, therefore, a tariff ordinance to govern the utilization of this government-owned gravel

Be it therefore ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Ipil in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the Ordinance Prescribing Regulations for the Commercial Utilization and/or Sale of the Quarry Material Extracted in Every Quarry Area Purchased by the LGU Ipil Or May Be Acquired by the LGU-Ipil.

SECTION 2. Definition of Terms. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- a. LGU-Ipil Quarry Site refers to the 2-hectare area purchased by the Local Government Unit of Ipil in Palomoc of Titay Municipality and such other quarry sites that may be acquired by the Municipality.
- b. Quarry resources refer to the quarry materials such as gravel, crushed stone that are necessary for the basic layering of road constructions, otherwise known as item 200, however, not limited but include such other quarry items that may be extracted in the future from the existing quarry site and in any area that the LGU of Ipil may acquire.
- Equipment refers to the heavy equipment owned by the LGU of Ipil which includes but not limited to dumptruck (6w), backhoe, and payloader.

SECTION 3. The Municipality, through the Municipal Treasurer, shall collect all payments for every cubic meter of quarry resource extracted based upon the computation provided for by the Municipal Engineering Office.

SECTION 4. Mayor's Permit. No person/s, corporation/s, association/s, partnership, contractor/s or any other entity shall be allowed to extract materials as defined in section 2 hereof without first securing a Mayor's Permit upon payment of the amount of one hundred pesos (P100) only as inspection fee.

SECTION 5. Schedule of fees. The Municipality shall charge and collect payments which shall be as follows:

- a. P220.00/cubic meter if LGU heavy equipments are used;
- b. P105.00/cubic meter if only the payloader is being used;
- c. P 75.00/cubic meter if none of the LGU heavy equipments are used; and
- d. An additional P5.55 per cubic meter for every succeeding kilometer for deliveries outside of the Poblacion area of Ipil.

SECTION 6. All payments shall accrue to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer which is mandated to promulgate rules and regulations for the prompt collection thereof.

SECTION 7. All resolutions, ordinances and laws of local effect inconsistent with this ordinance are modified, superseded or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the approval of the Municipal Mayor.

That this Ordinance was moved by the floor leader, seconded by SB Cleopatra Largo.
